- B. What did you do when you arrived.
- C. What workshops/seminars did you attend?
- D. What other activities/tours were there to do?
- E. What was the most important thing you learned?
- F. What was the most memorable part of your trip?

III. Conclusion

- A. Sum up the trip/experience.
- B. Do you have a piece of advice for those planning to attend next year?
- C. Did the trip inspire you to be more active in 4-H?
- D. Thank the Leaders' Association for helping you attend.
