

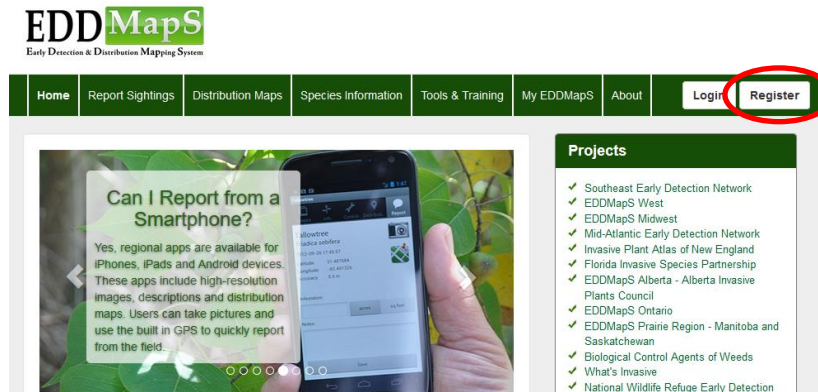


Great Lakes Early Detection Network App- Getting Started Guide

The Great Lakes Early Detection Network (GLEDN) App allows you to use your smartphone or cell-enabled tablet to easily collect and submit valuable invasive species observations. The GLEDN app is connected to the Early Detection & Distribution Mapping System (EDDMapS), a nationwide database of invasive species observations. Please complete the steps in this guide before attending a field training.

Step 1: Create an EDDMapS Account

Go to www.eddmaps.org and click on **Register** to create an account



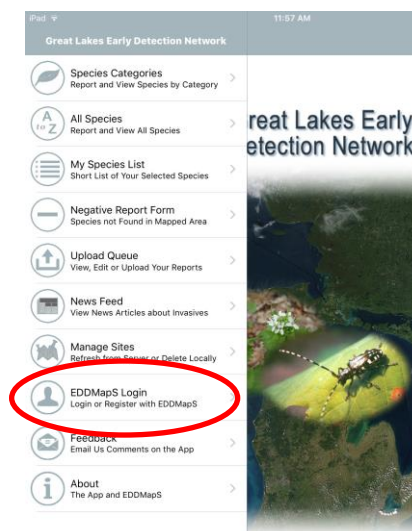
Step 2: Download the GLEDN App

To download the app, search for Great Lakes Early Detection Network in Google Play (Android users) or the App Store (Apple/iOS users).

Step 3: Login to EDDMapS from the GLEDN App

(Required to be able to submit observations)
Select **EDDMapS Login** from the main menu in the GLEDN app.
Then log in using your email and password for your EDDMapS account.
