Entries will be judged for suitability of garment to individuals and purpose in regards to color and design, general appearance, neatness, posture, fit, and construction (to the extent that it affects the general appearance).

All participants (ages 12+) are encouraged to participate in the Clothing Revue at The Wisconsin State Fair, August 1-11.
